UPDATED: COVID-19 Situation Report and Guidance

As of October 13, at 12 p.m., there are 17 new positive case of novel coronavirus (COVID-19) to report. That brings the total to 1223 positive cases of COVID-19 in Dubois County residents.

Since the beginning of stage 5 we have started seeing a rise of new cases of COVID-19 in Dubois County. Tracking investigations have led to the knowledge that most of these cases are due to community spread (i.e. special events, travel, bars, wedding, family gatherings etc.) Further investigation reveals that many people have let their guard down in regards to following the ongoing guidelines to mitigate this virus. Stage 5 did not lift these guidelines. At all times when we are around other people, outside of our home, we must continue to practice physical distancing and wearing a face covering.
