**UPDATED: COVID-19 Situation Report and Guidance**

As of July 22, at 8 a.m., there are 23 new positive cases of novel coronavirus (COVID-19) to report. This brings the total to 469 positive cases and 2 new related deaths of COVID-19 in Dubois County residents.
