UPDATED: COVID-19 Situation Report and Guidance

As of July 24, at 8 a.m., there are 28 new positive cases of novel coronavirus (COVID-19) to report. That brings the total to 514 positive cases and 1 new related death of COVID-19 in Dubois County residents.
