UPDATED: COVID-19 Situation Report and Guidance

As of July 30, at 8 a.m., there are 8 new positive cases of novel coronavirus (COVID-19) to report. That brings the total to 587 positive cases and 1 new related death of COVID-19 in Dubois County residents. The total number of deaths remains at 11, an investigation into a previously counted person concluded that COVID-19 was not listed as the cause of death.
